- 1 **Best Turned out In-hand**— Open to any horse/pony and is judged on correctness, cleanliness of horse and handler.
- 2 **Youngstock**—horse/pony 3years and under on 1st January of the current year. Colts aged 2 or 3 to be bitted. **Stars qualifier**
- 3 **Open Mountain and Moorland** — Open to all In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. **Stars qualifier small breeds and large breeds**
- 4 **Open Cob**— Open to any cob horse/pony to be shown hogged or natural. **Stars qualifier**
- 5 **Young Handler 4 to 8years** —open to all handlers to have attained their 4th birthday but not to have attained their 8th birthday on the 1st January 2025. Horse/Pony any height. **Stars qualifier**
- 6 **Young Handler 8 to 12years** —open to all handlers to have attained their 8th birthday but not to have attained their 12th birthday on the 1st January 2025. Horse/Pony any height. **Stars qualifier**
- 7 **Young Handler 12 years and over** —open to all handlers to have attained their 12th birthday but not to have attained their 18th birthday on the 1st January 2025. Horse/Pony any height. **Stars qualifier**
- 8 **Open Coloured**— Open to any coloured horse/pony hogged, plaited or Traditional including alternative colours. **Stars qualifier**
- 9 **Open Veteran**—Open to any horse/pony 14years and over on 1st January of the current year. **Stars qualifier**
- 10 **Open Miniature or Shetland**— Open to any Miniature or Shetland pony will be split if entries suffice.
- 11 **Open Show Horse or Pony inc. ROR**— Open to any show type horse/pony inc. ROR

15	Best Turned out Ridden — Open to any horse/pony and is judged on correctness, cleanliness of horse and rider. <i>*Stars qualifier*</i>
16	Beginners showing (walk and Trot only) - open to competitors new to showing. Combinations NOT to have been placed 1st in the class previous seasons. Entrants in this class can enter class 16 but may NOT enter classes 19 to 25
17	Novice showing - open to Novice riders/horses. Will be walk and trot in the go around and walk, trot, canter individual show piece. Entrants in this class can enter any other showing class providing they did not enter class 15
18	Lead Rein —pony not exceeding 13.2hands and rider not to have attained 10th birthday on 1st January of the current year. To be shown in snaffle and lead rein attached to the nose band. <i>*Stars qualifier for combinations on ponies under 128cm plaited and M&M*</i>
19	First Ridden —pony not exceeding 14 hands and rider not to have attained 12th birthday on 1st January of the current year. To be shown in snaffle. Canter optional. <i>*Stars qualifier for combinations on ponies under 128cm plaited and M&M*</i>
20	Equitation Junior —open to all competitors including lead rein. Judged only on the riding ability. 17yrs and under on 1st Jan of the current year. <i>*Stars qualifier for lead rein combinations on ponies under 128cm/first ridden on ponies under 128cm/off lead rein combinations not to have attained their 18th birthday 1st Jan 2025*</i>
21	Equitation senior —open to all competitors 18yrs and over on 1st Jan of the current year. <i>*Stars qualifier*</i> Ring Championship —Any Competitor place 1st and 2nd in classes 15—21 can take part. Prize for Champion and Reserve of ring plus member champion
22	Open Veteran —Open to any horse/pony 14years and over on 1st January of the current year. <i>*Stars qualifier 14-19 years and 20 years plus*</i>

Long Eaton Riding Club Rules

1. All persons attending LERC shows do so at their own risk. The organisers/landowner cannot accept responsibility for any loss or injury to any person, animal or property how so ever caused.
2. The Judges decisions are final.
3. Any objections must be handed to the Club Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £50 which will be forfeited if the objection is overruled by the appropriate procedure.
4. All riders under 18s years of age must have fastened current British Standard Riding Hat and appropriate footwear. No trainers whilst mounted, all exhibitors must be suitably dressed, including showing animal's in-hand. If you are aged 18 and over and would like to wear a Beagles/Bowler/Top Hat, you do so at your own risk. **WE STRONGLY ADVISE AND PREFER** that all persons wear a correctly strapped British Standard Hat, you will NOT be penalised for this in any classes. In all, including in-hand-classes people under the age of 18 must wear a British Standard Riding Hat. In all qualifier classes hats must be worn in accordance to the specific qualifiers rules.
5. You may wear a body protector IN ANY CLASS without being penalised.
6. Where the height or age of a horse or pony is disputed, the competitor will be asked to produce the relevant certificate.
7. Spurs may not be worn in M & M Ridden, Veteran. Anyone misusing spurs or whips in the Judges opinion will be disqualified.
8. The organisers reserve the right to limit or cancel classes or refuse entry to classes if time and or conditions dictate. If there are less than 4 entries in a class, organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or cancel that class.
9. Anyone who conducts themselves inappropriately to Judges, Officials, Spectators or their animal will be requested to leave the show ground or venue immediately. We reserve the right to request any persons to leave if their behaviour is not appropriate. Inappropriate behaviour will result in a ban from competing at ALL LERC show events in the future. The judge's decision is final.
10. Any horse or pony may have more than one rider provided that the combinations do not compete in the same class. The name of the horse or pony must stay the same for all its riders.

Long Eaton Riding Club Rules

11. Lead Rein Classes: Children are to be 9 years and under as at the 1st January in the current year. Must be in a snaffle bit and lead rein attached to the nose band. The lead rein handler must be able to handle the pony suitably. The pony must not exceed 13.2 on the lead rein**however qualifiers may state height of pony 12.2—which differs from our rules please check before you enter**

12. In the interests of Safety only walk your horse in the parking areas and between rings. Anyone seen trotting, cantering or galloping will be warned and potentially asked to leave to show ground.

13. Strictly NO LUNGING on the show ground.

14. On entering and leaving the show ground the main gate MUST be closed behind you and park where advised.

15. A competitor called by the judge will normally be given two minutes to present themselves, otherwise the class will proceed without them, unless the judge is otherwise informed. It's the competitor's responsibility to arrive at the class on time. **The organisers cannot be held responsible for classes which clash.**

16. Lane of unfit horses or ponies will be asked to retire from all events.

17. No horse or pony under 4 years of age is to compete in any ridden class.

18. Handlers of colts or stallions **MUST** be over 16 years old.

19. All dogs must be kept on leads and cleaned up after, anyone found to let a dog foul and not clear it up will be banned from LERC, dog faeces are a hazard and highly unpleasant.

20. Any questions or queries are to be put in writing and addressed to the Club Secretary, which can then be discussed / resolved at the next club meeting.

21. First Ridden Classes: rider not to have attained 12th birthday on 1st January of the current year**however qualifiers may state height of pony 12.2—which differs from our rules please check before you enter**

22. All competitors and spectators under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

23. Images of the show day may be posted on social media, if you do not wish to have your image used on social media please make us aware at the secretaries tent.
